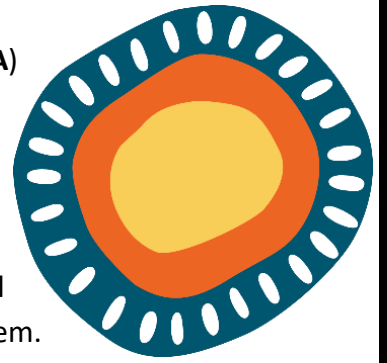
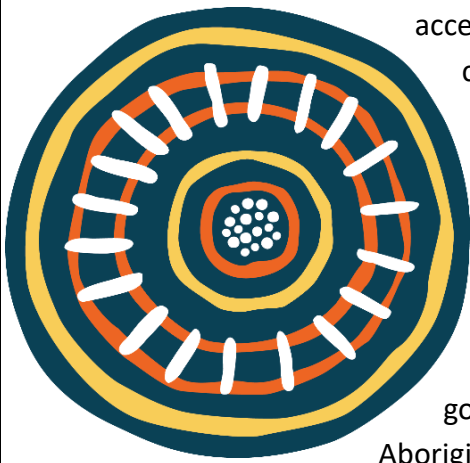


ALSWA Strategic Plan 2025 –2030 in focus

The Aboriginal Legal Service of Western Australia Limited (ALSWA) has released its 2025–2030 Strategic Plan, setting a bold and forward-looking direction to improve justice outcomes and strengthen the wellbeing of First Nations Peoples across Western Australia. The Plan reaffirms ALSWA’s commitment to delivering culturally secure legal services, expanding holistic program support, reducing unmet legal need, and driving structural reform to address the over-representation of Aboriginal people in the justice system.



Building on ALSWA’s long history as a leading Aboriginal community-controlled legal service, the Strategic Plan outlines a targeted and evidence-informed pathway for the next five years. It prioritises strengthened access to legal assistance; integrated, community-centred service delivery; culturally grounded and holistic support programs; and a renewed focus on digital modernisation and data-driven decision-making. These foundations will support better legal, social, cultural and wellbeing outcomes while enhancing ALSWA’s capacity to respond to emerging needs across metropolitan, regional and remote communities.



The Plan underscores ALSWA’s commitment to strong partnerships—with government, sector leaders, community organisations, Elders and Aboriginal communities—to achieve coordinated and lasting change. It highlights new priorities, including innovative approaches to justice, expanded cultural and restorative programs, holistic wellbeing and support services, and improved pathways for social mobility, economic participation, and leadership development among First Nations Peoples.

With a strong focus on cultural integrity, governance excellence, and long-term community resilience, ALSWA positions itself as a vital partner in delivering the commitments under Closing the Gap and shaping a more equitable and culturally safe justice system. The Strategic Plan demonstrates ALSWA’s unwavering dedication to creating systemic change, empowering communities, and building a fairer future for generations to come.
